The mission of Roshni Nilaya is to rescue vulnerable children and women to end the cycle of poverty, child abuse, child labor, child marriage and discriminations. We do this by:

A. Providing shelter, food and education through Child Care Institution project for the children between 5 and 18.

B. Giving college education scholarships through After Care Project for the CCI pass out.

C. Establishing Skill Development Center for providing livelihood, upliftment empowerment of the women and the poor.

D. Setting up community centers for free tuition, nutritious meal, promoting cultural activities and care.

E. Educating rural and migrated children through residential school and mobile school.

## College Education Scholarships

Roshni Nilaya helps children who complete school education residing in Child Care Institution. Most of the girl children coming out of CCI after attaining 18 years face quite lot of challenges than children with family care. Children who are orphans/semi orphan/abandoned/destitute coming out of CCI will end up in poverty, early marriage, abuse and unfulfilled dreams, this is where Roshni Nilaya intervenes to break the cycle of poverty, social evils and help child specially girl child to reach their destiny. College education or technical education is the only tool to transform their lives and make them self-reliant. At present, we help five children in providing college education sponsorships.

Nearly half of the children leaving child care institutions (CCIs) when they turn 18 years are unable to find paid work, according to a new study. The study said that even those who do find work, 93 per cent of them are salaried and 7 percent self-employed. The average monthly salary was between Rs 7,500 and Rs 8,500, according to a research conducted by NGO Udayan Care.

Especially the young girls discharged from Child Care Institutions suffer the most either they are married or become labourer and failed to fulfil their dream and live dignified life. Therefore, RN intervenes to make their ambitions coming into reality by providing scholarships for their college & technical education. We choose orphan/semi orphan and destitute children in need to offer an opportunity to pursue their desired course in reputed institutions so that they become self-reliant.



## Community Outreach

In 2019 we have reached out to community live in dire poverty. There are 40 families living under coconut leaves hut without basic amenities such as electricity, house, clean water and sanity. These people are called Boom Boom Mattukaran, they lived nomadic live but now they are settled in Erappapalayam, Avalpooundurai in Erode District. Most of them don't have ration cards to avail government ration provisions and they suffer a lot for survival. Almost 150 children live there and in 2019 three children were died due to heavy rain and living conditions moved our hearts to help them. Roshni Nilaya decided to help these families:

By providing Thar Sheets to cover their coconut leaves hut and for the floor and two bedsheets for their children in winter season worth Rs.1000/- to each family (on 05-12-2020)



On 18th January 2020, RN has decided to provide Chicken Biryani for entire community (40 families around 200 people) and it's very interesting that for the very first time they have community lunch like this. We have spent Rs. 30000/- for feeding the entire community and specially children were filled with great joy and excitement. Our volunteers' team helped us and made that day possible and great.

## Child Welfare Activities

During 2019-20, RN has done quiet lot of child welfare activities for the children based in Child Care Institutions. The Managing Director of Roshni Nilaya also served as Bethany Children's Home superintendent during 2019-20 and have seen children lacking many social activities due to finance strain, hence RN has decided to raise funds for children based in CCI to have one day tour, new dress purchase and for shopping & Exhibitions which usually Home administration can't afford from their regular funding.

**A** One day Tour on 05-12-2020 (We have taken all children of Bethany Children's Home to Coimbatore for One day tour, we left early in the morning visited VOC park and spent half a day there then left to Phoenix Mall had lunch there at KFC almost all children for the very first time had eaten there and watched Bigil Movie which all children enjoyed a lot)



**B** Bedding (In kind Donations)  
 (We have provided 15 Mattresses, pillows and one set of bed spread and bed sheets for the Bethany boy's home which is registered under J.J.Act)



**C** New Dress purchase for Diwali & Christmas 2019  
 (Most of the Children resided at home will not have opportunity to buy dresses while festival seasons, last year we have presented the needs with one of the business group and MD of Royal Wings Honda showroom came forward to support the children in buying new dress for Diwali.)

**D** Medical Aid (We have helped Nirtika and Pusphalatha for eye test and paid for speds)



**E** Family Based Care for Children (#RoshniNilaya has always encouraged education. These two girls, Shanmugam Priya and Vishnu Priya who had lost their father, were left unable to pay for their education. This is where we stepped in and helped them in paying their fee)





**F** Shopping Day (We have taken Children who weren't able to go home from CCI for holidays to Shopping and make them feel that they are special and someone to look after them and makes them feel happy from disappointments of not having family to look after)



**G** Appreciating Children (We used to encourage children who achieve in their education by providing educational needs) The Youth is the pillar of today's society and the future as well. Therefore, it is important to always encourage them. These are the children of Bethany Children's Home, who have passed their classes with flying colours.



We have also done many other activities like celebrating children's birthday for orphan and abandoned children to make them happy on the very special day in their lives. Continue to support our work in doing best interest of the child.

## Campaign & Celebrations

A 150 Years of Celebrating the Mahatma on 02-10-2019 at Bethany Children's Home by Cleaning & Plantation drive in the surrounding areas of the campus, cleansed the total area of the campus, planted trees and provided five 25 kg rice bags to the home. 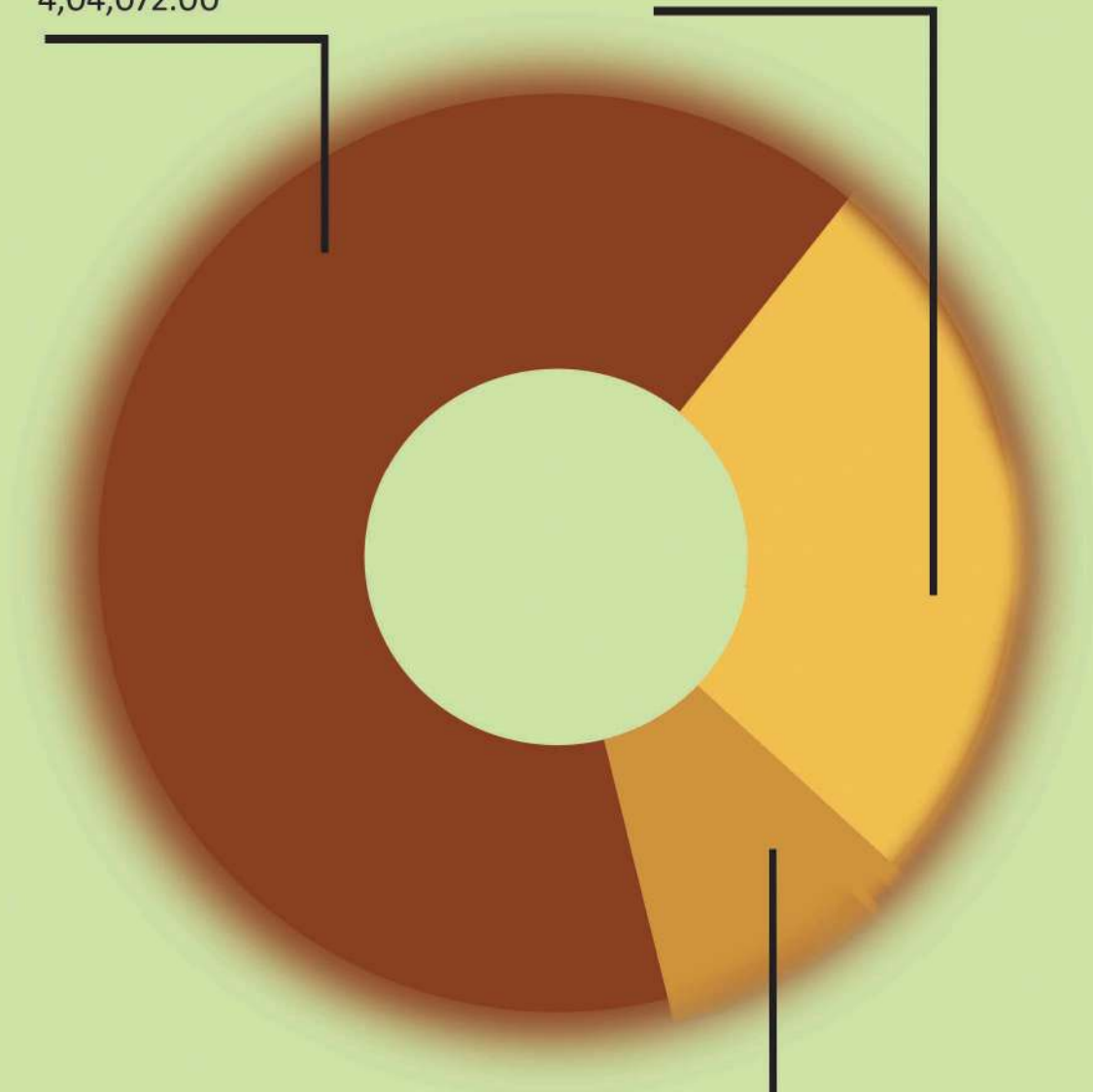
