Our team regularly engages in family visits, offering emotional support and guidance to both the children and their caretakers. Additionally, we go the extra mile by providing toiletries and snacks to the children, ensuring that their day-to-day needs are met. The community outreach activity aimed to **School Enrollment and Educational Support**: address the needs of the marginalized and underprivileged community residing in the Boom Boom Mattukaran area. The primary focus was on assisting individuals involved in begging, providing support for homeless individuals living in coconut leaf huts, and facilitating better educational opportunities for children. The following report outlines the various initiatives undertaken during the outreach program.

### Objectives:

Assist marginalized individuals, particularly those involved in begging, in improving their living conditions and overall well-being.

Facilitate the enrollment of children in schools and provide them with essential educational resources.

Enhance the quality of life for the community by providing a safe and comfortable community center for sleeping, recreation, and preschool

Improve access to healthcare through regular health check-ups.

Address the challenges faced during the rainy season by providing tarpaulin sheets and bedsheets.

Ensure regular attendance of school-going children by offering transportation facilities.

### **Activities**:

### Aadhaar Card and Community Certificate Assistance:

Conducted awareness sessions and assisted individuals in obtaining Aadhaar cards and community certificates, promoting their access to government welfare schemes and services.

Collaborated with local authorities and schools to enroll children in formal education.

Provided educational materials such as books, stationery, and uniforms to support their learning journey.

Organized mid-day meals on school holidays to ensure that children receive proper nutrition and encourage regular attendance.

### Construction of Community Center:

Built a community center to accommodate 15 families at night, offering them a safe and comfortable place to sleep.

Utilized the center for morning pre-school classes for children below 5 years.

Encouraged community members to utilize the center for recreational activities, fostering a sense of community and togetherness.

### Provision of Tarpaulin Sheets and Bedsheets:

Distributed tarpaulin sheets and bedsheets to protect the community members' homes during the rainy season, ensuring a safer and more comfortable living environment.

### Transportation Facility for School-Going Children:

Initiated a transport facility to ensure that school-going children have access to transportation, minimizing the risk of missing school due to distance or transportation challenges.
